

PUBLIC NOTICE for PUBLIC HEARING

Iowa, Louisiana

The Town of Iowa will hold a public hearing at 6:30 p.m. on June 14, 2021 at the Iowa Town Hall. The purpose of the meeting is to obtain views on the housing and community development needs of Town of Iowa and to discuss the submission of an application for funding under the State of Louisiana Community Development Block Grant - Coronavirus (LCDBG-CV) HVAC Program. The following items will be discussed at the hearing:

- A. The amount of funds available for proposed community development and housing activities;
- B. The range of activities available that may be undertaken, including the estimated amount of funds proposed to be used for activities that will benefit persons of low and moderate incomes;
- C. The plans of the Town for minimizing displaced persons as a result of activities assisted with such funds and the benefits to be provided by the Town to persons actually displaced as a result of such activities; and,
- D. The Town's past performance on LCDBG projects funded by the State of Louisiana.

All residents, particularly low and moderate income persons and residents of slum and blighted areas of the Iowa area are encouraged to attend this meeting.

Accommodations will be made for persons with disabilities and non-English speaking individuals provided that three-day notice of received by the Town of Iowa.
